COACHES:

- The coaches' meeting will start in the hospitality room at 8:45am
- We are going to need your help with field events; assignments to come.
- There will be hospitality food & drinks for coaches. **We need a total of how many coaches** you will be bringing NO LATER than 2/19/25 so that we can order enough food.

ENTRIES:

- Deadline for entries: Thursday, February 22 at 11:00 p.m.
- Entry Fee: \$225 per team (boys & girls) or \$125 per gender (if only bringing one)
- Entry fees can be mailed by 2/20 or brought to the Coaches meeting.

- Entry limits (GHSA entry limits per athlete apply)
 - Individual Events – 3 per school
 - Relays - 2 per school, except for 1 per school for 4x800

TEAM AREAS & EVENT CHECK-IN

- **Teams may set up in the visitor side stands or in the far left and right of the home stands.**
Team tents, if needed, should be placed at the top of the stands to allow spectators to view the meet unobstructed. Team tents may also be placed behind the fence on the right side (see map) away from walkways. NO tents may be placed on the home side except in stands.
- **Athletes should check in for their events at 1st Call.** The Clerk for running events will be in the end zone farthest from the large screen (see map below). Field event athletes can check in at their field event location.
- **Warmups**, except for the final strides, will be on the grass field behind the field house.
- **Athletes are not to be on the infield until allowed by Meet Officials.** At check-in, they will be held in a staging area pending the start of their event and will be released onto the infield at the appropriate time by Meet Officials. Any athlete found on the infield without permission other than to complete their warm-up or for competition may be disqualified.
- **Upon completion of their event, athletes must exit the infield.**
- **Electronic devices (phones, earbuds, headphones, etc.) are not allowed on the infield.**
- The **shotput area** is next to the home stands, farthest from the large screen.
- The **discus area** is on the practice field adjacent to the tennis courts (see map).

PARKING

- Please see the map on the last page of this document for parking information. Buses can drop off/pick up in front of the stadium doors, but should park in one of the Main Parking lots during the meet. Spectators and athletes should park in one of the Main Parking lots. There will be no parking or spectator/athlete drop off allowed in the lane closest to the track. **Please pass these maps & info along to all parents, spectators, coaches, bus drivers, etc.**
- Elderly spectators and those who may have issues walking from the Main Parking lots can be dropped off at the entrance of the stadium (see diagram) or may park in designated spots.

AWARDS:

- Top 3 in each event will medal
- Top 3 teams in each gender will earn a trophy
- Medals will be announced after each event, but medals will be given to coaches at the end of the meet.
- If you do not pick up your medals before you leave, please contact Heather Hunting to set up how you will receive them.

CONCESSIONS:

- Concessions will be available all day behind the concession stands. Cash, card, and apple pay are accepted.
- Food trucks: Kona Ice / Traveling Toms Coffee, and Southeast Funnel Cakes/Fries/Chicken truck will be available behind the home stands.
- Big Peach truck will also be on site for purchases.

GENERAL:

- 1/4" or shorter spikes only.
- **ONLY spike bags will be allowed on the field** – no electronic devices or other bags permitted.
- Coaches, please help us by reminding your athletes about these rules.
- Please also help by having your athletes clean your area of the stands before leaving. Trash bags will be available at the check-in tent and in the stands.
- **Bathrooms** are available to the right of the concession stands on the home side and underneath the visitor stands.
- **Lost and Found** will be available at the check-in tent.
- **NO ATHLETES** may be in the field house without authorization from us at any time.
- Our **Athletic Trainers** will be on the field by the visitor stands. By new GHSA policy, our trainers are happy to tape your athletes but they **MUST** bring their own tape. Please plan ahead for your athletes.
- We have a **clear bag policy** for spectators. Please see [HERE](#) for more information.
